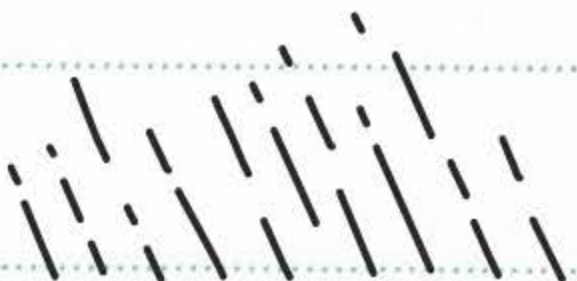

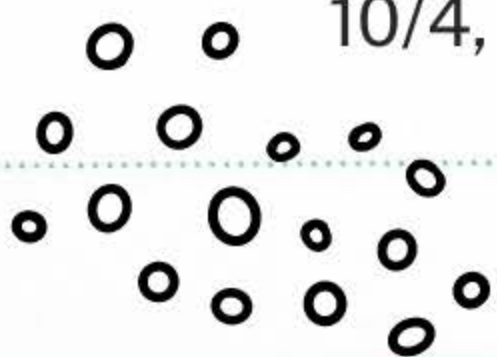


Bracelet Making Club

Green House Club



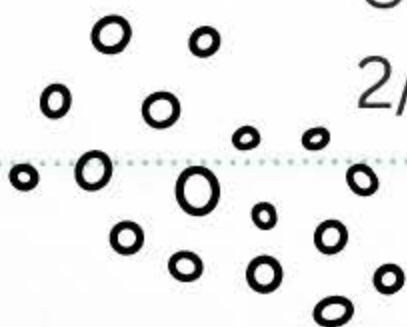

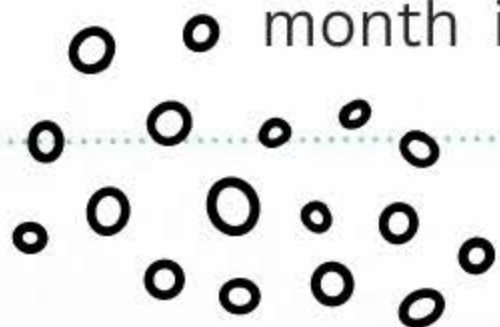

The Spanish Club is open to any current or former Spanish students, or any heritage speakers of the language. Our focus is on having fun with the language through music, movies, and cultural experiences.



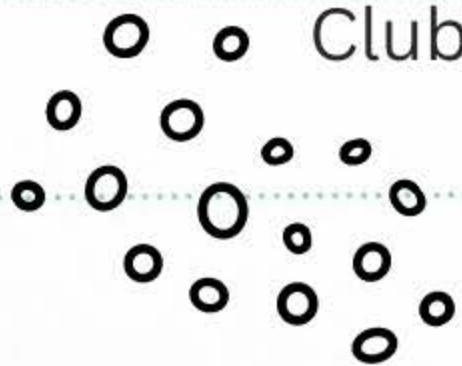

Join and become part of the robotics competitive team. Help build and guide the NSHS robot through challenges and competitions.



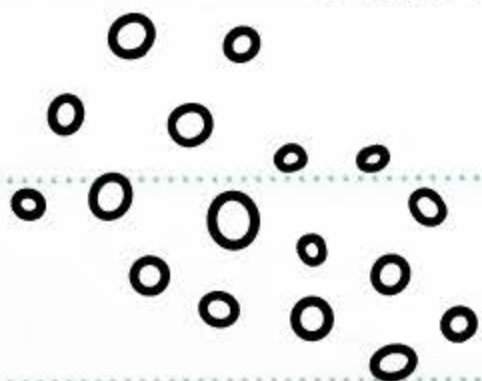

Starting in November this informal club meets to discuss important issues at the school, local, state, and national levels. It is student-driven.



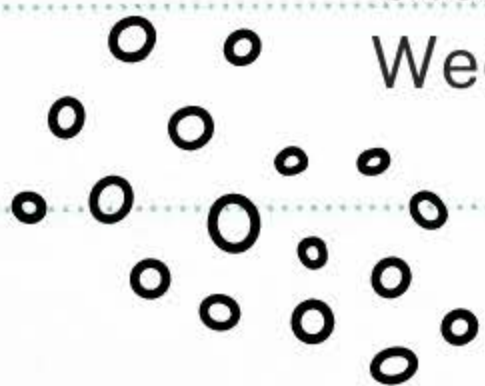

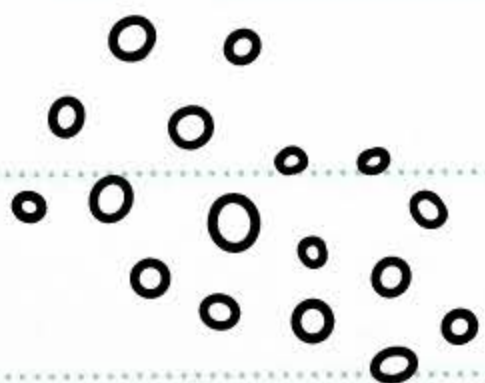

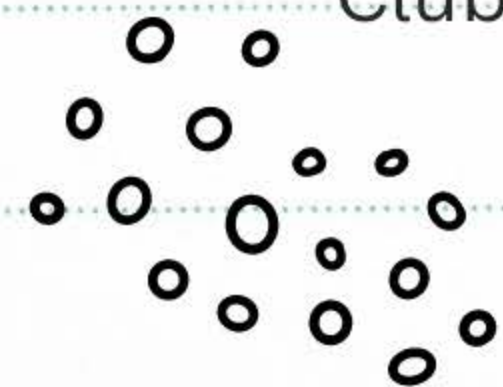

DECA is an extracurricular club that prepares emerging leaders and entrepreneurs for careers in marketing, finance, hospitality, and management.

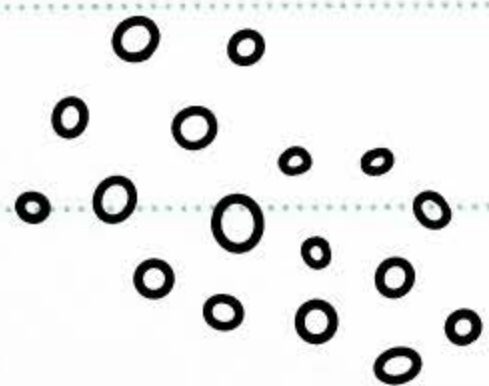
